Important notice about entries for the competition.

Vikingloppet is an international competition and is sanctioned by the international skating union (ISU). That means that every entry for the competition must go through your national skating union.

Prizes Gold, silver and bronze medals will be given on each distance. The 3 best skaters after 4 distances in each class will be awarded. Commemorative plaque will be given to every participator.

Number of participants About 20 skaters in each class. If we get too many announcements we reserve the rights to sort out among the participants.

Board and lodging Even this year we have made an agreement with Vilsta Sport- hotel, about 4 km from the ice stadium. That is a Youth Hostel with 4-bed- rooms. We have reserve 140 beds for our competition. All the meals will be served at the same hotel. The cost is 225:- SEK for each person and night, including breakfast. All other meals can be served at the same hotel and prices for lunch and dinner is set to 65:- SEK per meal. The rooms need to be **cleaned up** after residence.

Every person has to bring their own linen and towels. You can make your own reservations directly to Vilsta Sporthotell. The phone number is +46 16 513080 and say that you will participate in the Vikingloppet.

Friendship meal The friendship meal together with all prize ceremonies for Saturday will take place at Vilsta Sporthotel during Saturday evening. The cost of that is included if you both stay and/or eat at Vilsta. Otherwise, if you want to participate in Saturday evening, the cost is 85:- SEK for each person and is to be paid to the race cashier during Saturday.
